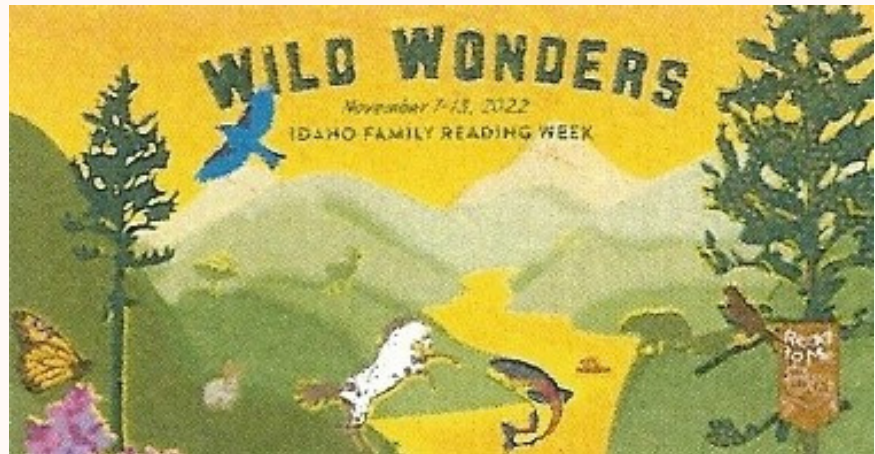

You'll need a library card to access the Libby app. If you don't have one -- or can't remember your patron number -- stop by the and we'll be happy to help get you started. Bring your driver's license and a piece of mail that shows your address. Library cards are free for those who live within the Hansen School District.

We're open 1 to 6 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays; and 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturdays.

Kindergarten Readiness Program begins in January

The Hansen Community Library has received a Kindergarten Readiness Grant from the Idaho Commission for Libraries to help 4- and 5-year-olds prepare to enter kindergarten next fall.

Part of the grant is being used to create early literacy kits that can be checked out by caregivers to help build letter and number recognition plus motor skills while having fun at home.

We will also begin offering programs at the library to work on the same skills January to March. The program will last about an hour and include caregiver tips.

Second STEAM Saturdays

Don't forget the Hansen Library is offering free STEAM activities every Second Saturday of the month from 10:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Stop by and stay for as long as you can. We may be looking at hairs under a microscope or building LEGO masterpieces or creating code for a robot.
