K Ready

Thanks to a grant from ICfL, our kindergarten readiness program returns for a 5-week session beginning Monday, Nov. 6 from 10 to 11 a.m. The second 5-week session begins Jan. 8

Thanks to help from the Idaho Association for the Education of Young Children, the Hansen Library will also host three Ready! for Kindergarten workshops. These 90-minute workshops will help parents and guardians of 3 to 4 years olds prepare for school.

Levy Override Vote Nov. 7

The Hansen Library is holding a \$30,000 permanent levy override vote on Tuesday, Nov. 7. All registered voters who live within the Hansen: Liibrary District (which is the same as the Hansen School District boundaries) may vote. If approved by a 66-2/3 percent majority, the new base budget would be \$88,557.

A few quick facts:

- 1) The Library has not asked for an increase in base funding since the library district was formed in 1986.
- 2) Property owners are paying approximately \$23 per \$100,000 of taxable property value. If the levy passes, it would add approximately \$12.50 per \$100,000 of value based on 2023 values. The new rate will still be about half the maximum levy rate allowed (.0006).
- 3) If the levy passes, the Hansen Library will not receive any new funds until January 2025.
- 4) The Library is limited, by law, to asking for a 3 percent increase on the base budget (now \$58,557).
